Rules and Regulation

1. To participate in the competition you should be enrolled in the +2 or its equivalent level.
2. You will be entertained in the competition only after registration made.
3. The information provided by you via the form is true in every term. If found incorrect at any stage of the competition then his / her candidacy can be cancelled.
4. If required, candidate must provide all the original testimonials.

Test Format

1. The Olympiad competition takes place in two phases: Tier I and Tier II.
2. Tier I test format is the multiple objective type which covers the basic aptitude question relating to the science of +2 or equivalents for which :
 - a. The time allocated for the test duration is 1 hour and 30 minutes with the total score of 150.
(Physics - 40, Mathematics - 40, Chemistry - 35 and Biology - 35)
 - b. Each question is credited with 1 score.
 - c. There is negative marking of **0.25** point for each wrong answer.
3. Tier II test format includes the multiple objective type as well as subjective types questions.

Selection Criteria

Tier I: Anyone who fulfills the above criteria can participate in the tier I competition by registering their name.

Tier II: The top 40 candidates from tier I will be selected for the second tier.

Awards

Certificates will be awarded for the eligible students for tier II.

Top three students of tier II will be awarded certificates with attractive prizes.

Important Instructions for Tier- I Test of Science Olympiad

- Arrive at the Exam Centre half an hour before the schedule time on the day of Exam.
- Bring the following with you:
 - (i) your hall ticket with photograph; (ii) two HB pencils; (iii) eraser; (iv) sharpener; (v) a ball point pen.
- Do not bring any of the following items with you inside the Examination hall:
 - (i) mobiles; (ii) calculators; (iii) log books; (iv) pagers; (v) any written material or papers
- You will be given a uniquely numbered OMR Sheet with 5-digits. It has two sides A and B. Do not mutilate/tear this OMR sheet.
- Side A contains Instructions and space for writing your (i) Registration No., (ii) Test Center Address and (iii) Examination Centre. There are two rows under examination Centre; give your centre code in the first row and name of city in the second row. They can be filled only by a ballpoint pen or HB pencil. Do not use any ink pen.
- Side-B of the OMR sheet will be filled only by HB pencil as shown by means of examples on side A.
- There will be one hundred fifty (150) multiple choice questions, each with four choices in your test paper.
- Select the correct answer for each question and shade only one appropriate box in the OMR sheet for the corresponding question.
- In the OMR sheet mark choose your answer only like ● (fully shaded in the circle with the choice number) but not in any other form such as ⊗, ⊙ or ⊕.
- Each correct answer carries one mark.
- 0.25 mark will be deducted for every incorrect answer.
- Return the OMR sheet alone after you have completed the test.
- Always double-check your registration number for its correctness on both sides A and B.
